

#### **Requested Amendment to The London Plan**

The purpose of the Comprehensive Review is to ensure that the London Plan policies: conform to Provincial Plans and Policies; implement the Key Directions and Vision of the Plan; and ensure growth is appropriately managed, with sufficient land designated to accommodate the projected long-term growth of the city's population, employment, and housing.

Amendments to The London Plan will be contingent on policy and land needs reviews of the Comprehensive Review. Amendments may relate to policies or mapping associated with permitted land uses in Place Types of The London Plan, intensities of uses permitted, redesignation of land uses, intensification targets of The London Plan, mapping delineating the settlement area boundary, and/or other policies identified during the Comprehensive Review.

#### Right to Appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Council of the Corporation of the City of London to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City of London before the proposed official plan amendment is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.
