



- ✓ Improve the pedestrian realm providing opportunities for comfort and connectivity;




Introduction

- ✓ Consideration of City of London plans, policies, standards, infrastructure initiatives, and guideline documents.









- Build trust, garner buy-in and foster genuine relationships based on mutual respect and dialogue.




Purpose of PIC #1

- Information gathered will help inform the development of the preliminary streetscape design.


