

# Notice of Public Update Meeting Colonel Talbot Road 2-Lane Upgrade

In response to ongoing and future development in the southwest part of the city, the City of London is preparing to upgrade Colonel Talbot Road from James Street to south of Southdale Road West, from a rural to urban road. This project is expected to begin in 2024 and is anticipated to last two (2) construction years. We are hosting a drop-in Public Update Meeting on **Thursday November 2**<sup>nd</sup> **between 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. at the Lambeth Public School** for residents and businesses to learn about construction impacts and see the near-final designs.

# **About the Project**

This project will convert Colonel Talbot from the current 2-lane rural road, with ditches and gravel shoulders, to a 2-lane urban road, with concrete curbs and gutter. Key elements such as sidewalks, streetlights, boulevard bike paths, landscaping features and pedestrian crossovers will be installed to enhance the comfort, accessibility, and safety for all road users through this rapidly growing community.

This project will be constructed primarily over a two (2) year period.

- 2024 construction will take place from the roundabout at Southdale Road to south of Diane Cres/ Royal Magnolia Road
- 2025 construction will take place from south of Diane Cres/ Royal Magnolia Road to James Street
- 2026 construction will consist of minor cleanup work and the placing of surface asphalt

There will be periods of road closures and detours during each construction phase. Further information about each phase, the stages within the phase, and the impacts will be provided in a subsequent letter prior to construction.

#### **Proposed Timeline:**

- Public update meeting #1: Occurred June 27, 2023
- Public update meeting #2: Thursday November 2, 2023
- Construction starts: Spring of 2024
- Construction ends: Fall of 2025 with minor cleanup and surface asphalt in 2026
