

Betty---I am requesting delegate status for the IEPC meeting on the October 15th to present a first quarter update on the two City funded projects under the Prosperity Initiative, as described below:

On July 2nd, 2013, the City of London entered into a Grant Agreement for "Employment Program Support" with WIL Counselling and Training for Employment. Please note that WIL Counselling and Training for Employment is acting as the administrative sponsor for the Employment Sector Council London Middlesex (ESCLM) and the London Middlesex Immigrant Employment Council (LMIEC). As part of the Grant Agreement, which was in the amount of \$101,980, the Employment Program Service Providers (ESCLM and LMIEC) were requested to provide job matching employment assistance services (as outlined in the agreement) and requested to report quarterly on the progress. In that regard, Anne Langille, Executive Director at WIL Counselling and Training for Employment will provide the IEPC committee with a verbal update as to the progress and overall program effectiveness of both ESCLM and LMIEC in the first quarter of program delivery.
