Just two(2) things to offer and consider ;

1. I fully support Councillor S Trosow’s items for direction motion as agenda Item 4.1 . I honestly can’t even fathom being a Ward 6 Councillor ( or any adjacent Council Ward ) representing the Wonderland – Oxford area and having next to zero City Of London Traffic impact and Active Transportation Planning solid cumulative data to respond & share @ Ward residents & business owners on the impact of each individual planning application as a “ designated transit hub “ development area.

2. I believe both this CWC & our full Council should use this motion as a long overdue opportunity to direct the City of London and the Integrated Transportation Committee & its TMP to “ pulling forward “ planned solutions ASAP in this zone ( Oxford & Wonderland – Transit hub ) as a **concurrent development requirement** prior to further densification approvals. I get long term planning is policy is required by the Active Transportation Committee but the City of London can’t freeze time for 3 – 4 years while this has developed to without responding to both our population growth ( 6 – 7 % ) , and Rapid Transit Hub planning needs moved forward as a priority . Get boots on the ground fast on this , its not a cost but a requirement !

This is exactly why Infrastructure costs are SOOO high as City of London only commits & spends on infrastructure after full development has already occurred and construction is 5 X as disruptive . Next stop Sunningdale RD folks , your 3 – 4 years behind.
