SUBJECT	AMENDMENTS TO THE TRAFFIC AND PARKING BY-LAW
	COMMERCE ROAD

RECOMMENDATION

That on the recommendation of the Acting Director, Roads & Transportation, the <u>attached</u> proposed by-law (Appendix "A") **BE INTRODUCED** at the Municipal Council meeting to be held on January 10, 2012 for the purpose of amending the Traffic and Parking By-law (P.S. 111) on Commerce Road.

BACKGROUND

City staff were contacted by a Commerce Road property owner who raised safety concerns when vehicles are parked on both sides of the road. At the request of the property owner, a mail-back survey was conducted on Commerce Road to determine if the other property owners supported prohibiting parking on both sides of Commerce Road from Wilton Grove Road to north end of the street. Fifty percent (50%) of the property owners responded to the survey with the majority of respondents supporting the parking regulation change. Brose Canada Inc. has requested that the parking prohibition be delayed until their parking lot is constructed in 2012.

The majority of property owners supported the parking prohibition; therefore, it is recommended that parking be prohibited on both sides of Commerce Road. An amendment is required to Schedule 2 (No Parking).



APPENDIX "A" BY-LAW TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC & PARKING BY-LAW (P.S. 111)

Bill No.

By-law No. PS-111

A by-law to amend By-law PS-111 entitled, "A by-law to regulate traffic and the parking of motor vehicles in the City of London."

WHEREAS subsection 10(2) paragraph 7. of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws to provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable to the public;

AND WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. No Parking

Schedule "2" (No Parking) of the said By-law PS-111 is hereby amended:

Commerce Both Wilton Grove North end of said Anytime Road Street

2. This by-law comes into force and effect on the day it is passed.
