Chair S Lewis and all members of the SPPC. Please consider this communication as rate payer & customer feedback with respect to Item 2.2 - MAP and the consent report offered up by our Deputy Manager – A.L. Barbon & Director Stewart.

- To my knowledge, there has never been even a "whiff "of Public Input offered up by Meetings Public Notice or by our "Get Involved London "website process with respect to the Budgeted \$125 Million MAP initiative; which is really an outlier in our City of London business development process.
- This report is calling for your approval (Consent) to move to the critical stages of both RFQP and later RFQ without that input on the key objectives of the MAP program and the scope to get there without Public Input; and that's risk going forward.
- At very least this Public Input Process should **occur concurrent** with the RFQP process and before the RFP .

There are many rate payers that I have talked to that are strongly supportive of decentralizing City of London services off "Campus " such as Transit Hubs & Mall Locations with improved access and more family focused hours of service. We only need to look at the recent direction the County of Middlesex took with respect their new south London City Hall as an example or US models of public – private partnerships on this Municipal services centres.
