Hello, I am emailing to object to the consideration that Bruce St. and Elmwood Ave. be made into two-way traffic. My husband and I live at 132 Bruce Street, which is just west of Wortley. Bruce Street is a very narrow street and will not allow for two-way traffic and parking of vehicles on one side of the street. There are also many large service trucks that deliver goods to the businesses off the alley-drive (behind Wortley) or simply park on the street in order to deliver their products to the restaurant/pub. Even now it is difficult for the LTC bus to have barely enough room to get by. This would be ridiculously compounded if traffic was trying to go both ways. The intersection at Bruce and Wortley is already busy and challenging enough without the added confusion of cars going BOTH ways at a 4-way stop. This is the problem as we see it and that is only from our perspective of the blocks between Wharncliffe and Wortley. I'm sure you are hearing from the people who live east of Wortley up to Ridout St. where the street is just as narrow. And if this proposal were to eliminate all parking on Bruce or Elmwood, that would cause MANY patrons who shop in Wortley Village to have to find parking elsewhere.
