Re: Removal of 1927 Richmond St, London from the Register of Cultural Heritage Resources

On behalf of the Winder Family, I am writing to request your support for the removal of 1927 Richmond St from the Register of Cultural Heritage Resources.

We have diligently followed the City of London's prescribed processes and the advice of heritage staff throughout this application. Our request is based on the following key points:

- 1 Independent Cultural Heritage Evaluation Report (CHER): We commissioned a qualified heritage professional to conduct a thorough CHER of the property. This report concluded with a recommendation to remove the property from the Register.
- 2 City Heritage Staff Support: The findings of the CHER have been endorsed by the City's Heritage Staff, who support the property's removal from the Register.
- 3 Advisory Committee Approval: The Community Advisory Committee on Planning (CACP) committee has voted unanimously in favor of recommending the property's removal from the Register.
- 4 Community Need: We urge the Committee to consider the pressing requirement for a new high school in this rapidly developing area of north London, which this property could facilitate.

We appreciate your careful consideration of this matter and respectfully request your support for the removal of 1927 Richmond St from the Register of Cultural Heritage Resources.
