I am writing this letter with respect to the re-zoning of 193 Clarke Road.

My wife and I have lived at 1824 Sudbury Avenue for 50 years. We have raised three children, grand-children and now great grand-children.

This area is currently zoned for “SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL” the space is not for the type of building the developer wishes to build. I can speak for myself as well as my neighbours that we have invested a lot of time and money to beautify our homes and we specifically choose to live in this area. We all have gardens and take pride in ownership of our homes and gardens.

This area has been a residential for over 50 years and it is my opinion this should remain this way in the future. My wife and I are extremely upset by the fact that with all of the available land in the City why would the zoning committee consider changing this residential area that has not changed in over 50 years, rather than look to alternate areas which would be more suitable.

There is plenty of open land in the City of London which would not require re-zoning and would be far more suitable for this development.
