Animal Welfare Advisory Committee

City-hired Veterinarian

- Improves accountability and transparency
- Can ensure best humane practices are used when ending the life of an animal
- Very cost effective and can contribute to preventive spay/ neuter programs

Costs for City-Hired Veterinarian

- One-time capital: \$300,000 – modular facility
- Ongoing operational: \$125,000 yearly salary

Cat Adoption Centre

- Joint venture between the City and Community Partners
- House and display cats in a pleasant environment to increase adoptions
- Can include dogs in the future



Cost of Cat Adoption Centre

- One-time capital: \$400,000 - modular facility to be placed on city-owned property
- Ongoing operational: \$200,000

Donations

- Service enhancements encourage donations
- London already has a donation program ready to expand
- Visible facilities like an Adoption Centre attract attention and encourage community support
