

Type A - Parking space for persons with disabilities



- Rate calculation requirement for all new development based on Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) requirements




- a) Type A Parking space for persons with disabilities

- d) International Symbol of Access






 a) Type A Parking spaces for persons with disabilities (Van Accessible)







 b) Type B Parking spaces for persons with disabilities








c) Accessible Parking Sign


 Accessible Parking Sign and International Symbol of Access are both required

Accessible Parking Sign for Type A and Type B: (Schedule 28(a))




