Good evening,

I am writing to request delegation status at the Infrastructure and Corporate Services Committee meeting on Monday, March 23, 2026, with respect to Agenda Item 2.11 – Meadowlily Environmental Assessment – Notice of Completion.

Development Engineering London Limited (DevEng) has been retained by Forever Homes Meadowlily Limited Partnership in connection with the development of 168 Meadowlily Road South, a draft approved plan of subdivision situated within the Meadowlily EA study area.

In reviewing the EA documentation, we note that the study recommends a pumping station to provide sanitary servicing to an undefined portion of developable lands within the study area. On behalf of our client, we wish to appear before the Committee to respectfully inquire as to whether gravity sanitary servicing alternatives were meaningfully evaluated as part of this process, and to understand the basis upon which those options, if considered, were dismissed in favour of a forcemain/pumping station solution.

As proponents of a draft approved subdivision within the study area, the preferred servicing strategy has direct implications for our client's development, and we believe it is important that the Committee be aware of this perspective prior to receiving the Notice of Completion.

We respectfully request the opportunity to address the Committee at the March 23rd meeting.
