I get that the recommended \$ 5 Million fund structure is flowing from the HAF fund bucket in all options but a vote to cancel for now and reconsider .

What I don't get is that there is zero disclosure in this report at this milestone meeting of the total RO Magnitude operational costs us taxpayers are burdened with to manage and execute this program in terms of FTE staffing and Legal Costs from inception to wrap up ; as well as the off ramp for this staff and commitments.

I welcome any motion from any SPPC Committee member at his meeting to add this information (OPS Budget Adjustments or other funding buckets \$\$ 2026 / 27) to the Public Record before proceeding . Maybe a Financial Institute like a local Credit Union partnership should manage this for us !
