Possible Amendments to The London Plan

The purpose and effect of this amendment is to update The London Plan to align with the “employment area” policies of the Provincial Planning Statement, 2024, and the “area of employment” definition and provisions of the Planning Act.

Amendments to The London Plan may relate to policies or mapping associated with permitted land uses in Place Types of The London Plan, consideration of Employment Area removals, and other policies identified.

How Can You Participate in the Planning Process?

You have received this Notice because the City may consider changes to The London Plan Place Types or policies of land located within 120 metres of a property you own. The City reviews and makes decisions on such planning applications in accordance with the requirements of the *Planning Act*. We are inviting your comments on the changes being considered at this time so that we can consider them as we review the application and prepare a report that will include Planning & Development staff’s recommendation to the City’s Planning and Environment Committee. Please provide your comment by April 5th, 2026 to the file planner listed on the first page of this Notice.

Attend a Future Public Participation Meeting

The Planning and Environment Committee will consider the possible amendments to The London Plan on a date that has not yet been scheduled. The City will send you another notice inviting you to attend this meeting, which is required by the Planning Act. You will also be invited to provide your comments at this public participation meeting. A neighbourhood or community association may exist in your area. If it reflects your views on this application, you may wish to select a representative of the association to speak on your behalf at the public participation meeting. Neighbourhood Associations are listed on the [Neighbourgood](https://neighbourgood.ca) website. The Planning and Environment Committee will make a recommendation to Council, which will make its decision at a future Council meeting.

What Are Your Legal Rights?

Notification of Council Decision

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the City of London on the proposed official plan amendment, you must make a written request to the City Clerk, 300 Dufferin Ave., P.O. Box 5035, London, ON, N6A 4L9, or at docservices@london.ca. You will also be notified if you speak to the Planning and Environment Committee at the public meeting about this application and leave your name and address with the Clerk of the Committee.

Right to Appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal

If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Council of the Corporation of the City of London to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City of London before the proposed official plan amendment is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City of London before the proposed official plan amendment is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the

Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
