**To the Chair and Secretary of the Strategic Priorities and Policy Committee:**

I am writing on behalf of Sifton Properties Limited with regard to Scheduled Item No. 2 on today's 4:00 pm Committee meeting (GMIS Annual Review and Update).

Sifton supports the report, but requests one minor amendment. This issue has been discussed with City Finance staff today.

Unfortunately, we failed to note a technical inconsistency when we reviewed the draft information provided by staff in December of 2013.

We ask that GMIS Item – “**North Lambeth SWMF P7**” be moved in the proposed schedule **from 2022 to 2017**.

This amendment ensures that portions of the tributary area served by the proposed sanitary sewer system and pumping station on Colonel Talbot Road in this area, also has SWM control measures at the same time.

This will ensure that the new sanitary sewer and pumping station are utilized efficiently once constructed at the scheduled time (as opposed to an approximate 5 year-delay, if the SWM pond timing stays as currently shown in today's report).

As noted above, this issue was discussed with Finance Department staff today.

We further understand that this item needs to be introduced by the Committee Chair (Mayor Fontana), and we respectfully request the Mayor's assistance in this regard.
