A. PURPOSE OF THIS AMENDMENT

The purpose of this Amendment is:

1. To amend Schedule B-1- Natural Heritage Features, to delete a portion of the "Unevaluated Vegetation Patch".

B. <u>LOCATION OF THIS AMENDMENT</u>

1. This Amendment applies to lands located at 1473 Dundas Street and 632, 646 and 652 Hale Street in the City of London.

C. <u>BASIS OF THE AMENDMENT</u>

The recommended Official Plan amendment to delete a portion of unevaluated vegetation patch 04017 from Schedule B-1, Natural Heritage Features of the Official Plan is appropriate after reviewing the significance of the existing woodland as per O.P. Policy 15.4.5.1 and determining that no significant features exist in the area of the patch identified.
