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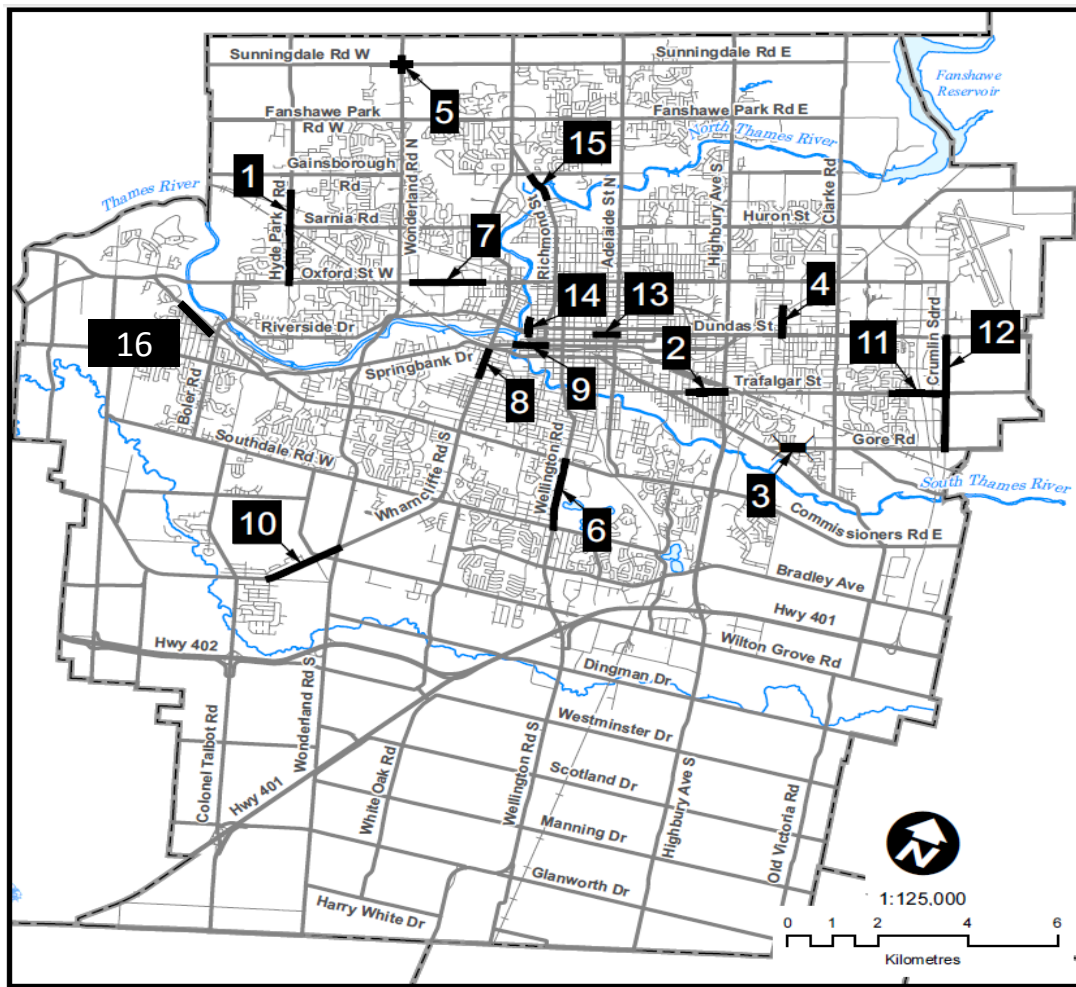

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Major Infrastructure Project	Schedule
1. Hyde Park Road Widening	Early April to late November
2. Trafalgar Street (Water, sewer & road) *	May to November
3. Gore Road Bridge Replacement.....*	May to late November
4. Second Street (Water, sewer and road).....*	May to November
5. Sunningdale / Wonderland Road Intersection.....*	June through September
6. Wellington Road South (Water and road)	May to late August
7. Oxford Street West (road resurfacing)	July & August
8. Wharncliffe Road South (road resurfacing).....	May & June
9. York Street (London Hydro and road resurfacing).....	May to August
10. Wharncliffe Road (road resurfacing)	June to August
11. Trafalgar Street East (road resurfacing).....	June to August
12. Crumlin Side Road (road resurfacing).....	June to August
13. Dundas Street (Water and road).....	July to September
14. Ridout Street North (Sewer and road).....	May to September
15. Richmond Street North (Developer – sewer & road)	May to August
16. Commissioners Road West (Water and Road).....	May to October

* denotes a road closure





2014 Major Infrastructure Construction Program

- \$80 to 90 M worth of construction projects (depending on tender values)
- 92 lane km of roadway being reconstructed or rehabilitated
- Includes road closures at:
 - Trafalgar Street, west of Highbury Avenue
 - Second Street, north of Dundas Street
 - Sunningdale / Wonderland Road Intersection

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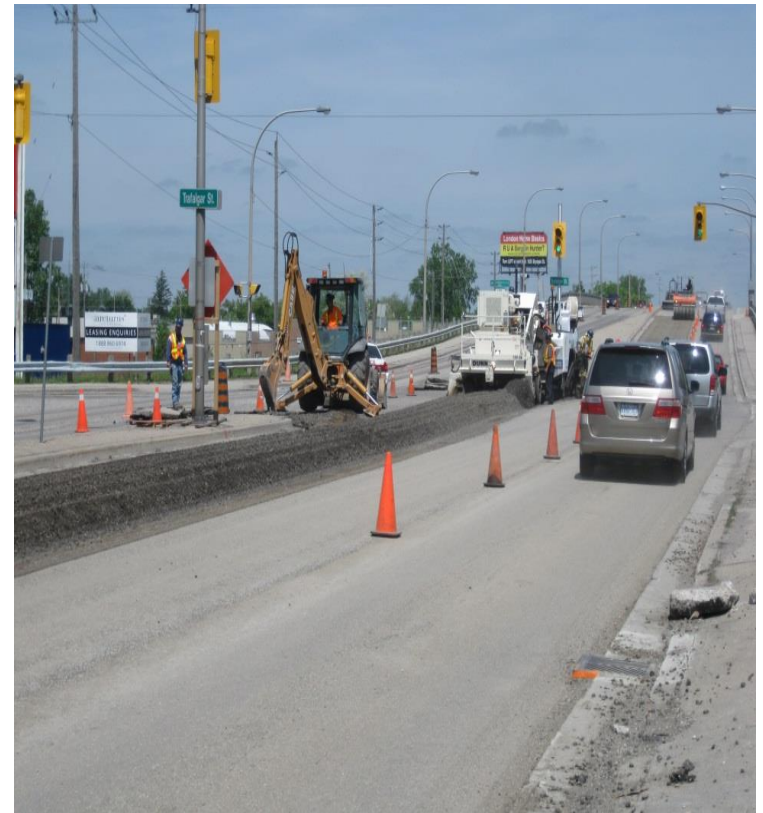
- Impacts minimized by:
