

| 5. Sunningdale / Wonderland Road Intersection.* | June through September |
| 6. Wellington Road South (Water and road) | May to late August |
| 7. Oxford Street West (road resurfacing) | July & August |
| 8. Wharncliffe Road South (road resurfacing) | May & June |
| 9. York Street (London Hydro and road resurfacing) | May to August |
| 10. Wharncliffe Road (road resurfacing) | June to August |
| 11. Trafalgar Street East (road resurfacing) | June to August |
| 12. Crumlin Side Road (road resurfacing) | June to August |
| 13. Dundas Street (Water and road) | July to September |
| 14. Ridout Street North (Sewer and road) | May to September |
| 15. Richmond Street North (Developer – sewer & road) | May to August |
| 16. Commissioners Road West (Water and Road) | May to October |

 - Minor Works, Special Events, etc.




