I YOUR COMMITTEE REPORTS:

The Plight of Pollinators

1. (9) That the Advisory Committee on the Environment (ACE) received a communication from M. Does and a verbal presentation from C. Lemire, Pollinator Sanctuary London, and held a general discussion with respect to concerns of the use of neonicotinoid pesticides and pollination in the City of London. The ACE struck a working group, consisting of G. Sass, T. Khan, C. Baird, N. St. Amour, M. Temme and C. Lemire, to review these matters and to report back at a future meeting.

Neonicotinoid Pesticides

2. That the Advisory Committee on the Environment (ACE) received a verbal presentation from M. Temme with respect to neonicotiniod pesticides.

Education Sub-Committee 3. (d) That the Advisory Committee on the Environment (ACE) reviewed and received a communication dated February 2, 2014, from C. Baird, on behalf of the Education Sub-Committee. The ACE approved that no further action be taken at this time with respect to electromagnetic radiation pollution and requested its Committee Secretary to update A.
