Bill No. 208 2014

By-law No. A.-____

A By-law to approve the 2014-2017 Multi-Sector Service Accountability Agreement between The Corporation of the City of London and the South West Local Health Integration Network, for funding for the Adult Day Program; and to authorize the Mayor and the City Clerk to execute such agreement.

WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care may provide funding to a local health integration network under the *Local Health System Integration Act*, 2006:

AND WHEREAS a Local Health Integration network, established under the *Local Health System Integration Act, 2006*, may provide funding to a health service provider, defined to include a municipality maintaining a long-term care home, in respect of services that the service provider provides in or for the geographic area of the network;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

- 1. The 2014-2017 Multi-Sector Accountability Agreement (M-SAA) to be entered into between The Corporation of the City of London and the South West Local Health Integration Network, for the provision of funding with respect to the Adult Day Program, attached as Schedule "A" to this By-law, is approved.
- 2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are authorized to execute the agreement approved in section 1 above.
- 3. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the day it is passed.
