However there are few access points on the south side of the south branch of the river that do not exist.

One can easily construct a bike path on the south side from Adelaide Street to Meadowlilly Road (this path and area would equal to our Springbank Park in the West) or the North side of the river.

Access point could easily be made from Trevithen St ( Watson Park), next Gladstone St ,

Pond Mill Rd, (underneath PMR no problem)

Shelbourne subdivision (already exist ) underneath Highbury Rd (no problem)

This would give the south end residents and excellent place to walk or bike in a loop just like Springbank Park or the North End of the city.
