4. That, on the recommendation of the General Manager of Environmental and Engineering Services and City Engineer, the following actions be taken with respect to Council Policy on Public Notification:

- (a) the proposed attached and amended by-law (Appendix "B") **BE INTRODUCED** at the Municipal Council meeting to be held on November 19, 2007 to adopt a new Council Policy with respect to Public Notification for Construction Projects and to repeal the current Council Policies 7(14) and 7(15) and the related appendices; and
- (b) the Civic Administration **BE ASKED** to investigate and report back with respect to whether or not landlords or superintendents can be given the responsibility of notifying their tenants when they receive construction notices;

it being noted that the Environment and Transportation Committee reviewed and received communications dated October 29, 2007 and November 11, 2007 from D. Dimitrie, #705-752 Kipps Lane and a communication dated November 12, 2007 from G.
