## BACKGROUND

As part of the expanded the scope of animal welfare initiatives, Municipal Council has directed City staff to issue a RFP to seek the services of veterinarians in the area of shelter medicine. The preparation and issuance of the RFP is part of a procurement process to identify, qualify and select a private partner or partners as a part of the service models utilized by the City in the delivery of animal welfare services. The scope of work focussed on the following:

- Triage for all animals entering the municipal shelter
- Shelter Services
- Spay/Neuter surgeries
- Micro-chipping procedures

## **RFP Submissions**

Submissions for the RFP closed on May 15, 2014. There was one submission received: a mobile veterinary service consisting of a team of veterinarians. Continued discussions with the respondent are underway and Civic Administration will report back as soon as the proposal review reaches completion.
