Re: Downtown Development

I thought it was a good time to update you on Sifton's thoughts toward one of the Downtown Development opportunities we can offer.

As you know we have been working with the Grand Theatre on their future development opportunities. These have been focused on our 495 Richmond Street parking lot. Although details still needed to be finalized Sifton and the Grand are in general acceptance to work towards their growth opportunities on our site.

One of the more recent concepts includes some parking for our 495 Richmond building, as well as a high-rise residential tower in connection with the Grand's opportunities. The residential tower would be above the parking structure and the Grand's expansion.

For this option to work Sifton would need to trade land parcels with the City (or the Grand as the case might be). The parcel in question would be the Queens Avenue lot we have discussed previously.
