This letter is to request the City of London to designate our event, Lawn Summer Nights, as "municipally significant" for purposes of fulfilling our filing requirements in submitting an Application for a Special Occasion Permit with the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario. Lawn Summer Nights was incorporated under the Canada Not-for-profit Corporations Act on February 8, 2013, as an organization to champion the fight against Cystic Fibrosis by creating awareness, educating and fundraising for the cause.

The event started in 2009 in Vancouver, BC, and has since expanded to seven cities across Canada. 2014 marks the second year the event will take place in London, ON. Since inception, Lawn Summer Nights has raised over \$565,000 to help those living with Cystic Fibrosis in Canada.

The event will be held Thistle Lawn Bowling Club, located at 25 Beaufort Street, London, ON, N6G 1A6. The event is taking place over 4 consecutive Thursdays in July, on July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and concluding on July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2014. It is a pledge-based event where teams raise funds and play as a team on the aforementioned dates.
