# PROGRESS REPORT

### **DISCOVERY PARK** (310 Windermere Road)

Western University and World Discoveries continue to work through the planning process of establishing Discovery Park as a leading Research Development and Commercialization Centre in the areas of Health Sciences, IT, Medical Devices, Imaging and Analytics.


## **ADVANCED MANUFACTURING PARK** (AMP)

The AMP continues to advance their plans as they relate to materials, wind, automotion, power and the environment.

The WindEEE Dome is now complete and operational.

Fraunhofer Project Centre is now complete and operational.

The Collider Centre (Centre For Technology Commercialization) is now complete and



operational.

#### **WORLD DISCOVERIES**

World Discoveries continues to work on the business plan and funding submission to the Provincial Government. The funding request will include the AMP Centre Expansion, Stiller Centre Expansion, BioMedical Imaging/Simulation Centre, Innovation Village as outlined in previous reports from World Discoveries.

#### **WESTERN UNIVERSITY**

Western is currently working on updates to the existing Master Plan for the Campus. It is anticipated the consultation process will commence in the Fall of 2014.

Public Consultation for the Western Road Environmental Assessment, extending from Platts Lane to Oxford Street, which includes the northern limits of Wharncliffe Road and the Oxford Street intersection have commenced. The first Public Inquiry Centre took place in June and a second is being planned for late fall 2014.

Public consultation for the Western Road Environmental Assessment at the Philip Aziz and Western Road (at Sarnia Rd.) Intersection is currently in the planning stages and has yet to commence.

#### **WESTERN UNIVERSITY and FANSHAWE COLLEGE**

June 23, 2014, Western University and Fanshawe College presented their proposed Integrated Campus Advance Manufacturing Plan to IEPC.

Council Resolved that the request for the allocation of additional land to fulfill the future needs of the Advanced Manufacturing Park, as identified in its Master Plan, BE REFERRED to the Civic Administration for review, in liaison with the stakeholders, and report back at a future meeting of the Strategic Priorities and Policy Committee; it being noted that the report back would address details such as timing, the amount of land involved, Urban Growth Boundary implications, as well as any other relevant considerations; it being further noted that the Strategic Priorities and Policy Committee (SPPC) heard a presentation (as attached to the SPPC Agenda) from A. Chakma, President and Vice Chancellor, Western University, Peter Devlin, President, Fanshawe College and Paul Paolatto, Executive Director, Western Research Parks and WORLDiscoveries), with respect to this matter.
