That, on the recommendation of the City Clerk, the City of London Day at the Budweiser Gardens for the London Celebrates Canada 50th Anniversary of the Canadian Flag, originally approved by the Municipal Council to be held on Sunday, February 15, 2015, BE RESCHEDULED to Saturday, February 7, 2015, at the request of the London Celebrates Canada and the Budweiser Gardens; it being noted that the Canada Sesquicentennial Anniversary of Confederation will continue to be held on Wednesday, February 15, 2017, as previously approved by Municipal Council.

BACKGROUND

Municipal Council, at its session held on December 6 and 7, 2011, resolved:

*“That, on the recommendation of the City Clerk, and in accordance with the policy for City events at the John Labatt Centre, the following events **BE APPROVED** as a City of London Day at the John Labatt Centre:*

London Celebrates Canada – Sunday, February 15, 2015 – 50th Anniversary of the Canadian Flag, Wednesday February 15, 2017 – Canada’s Sesquicentennial Anniversary of Confederation.”

Subsequent to the above-noted approval with respect to the proposed Sunday, February 15, 2015 event, we have been advised by the Regional Vice President & General Manager of the Budweiser Gardens that there is a conflict with the February 15, 2015 date. As a result, the date of this date has been changed to Saturday February 7, 2015. The change in date for the event requires the Municipal Council approval. The approval of the February 15, 2017 date for the Canada’s Sesquicentennial Anniversary of Confederation, remains as approved.
