By-law No. A.-

A By-law respecting the composition of The London Public Library Board.

WHEREAS section 9(1) of the *Public Libraries Act, R.S.O. 1990,* Chapter P.44, as amended, provides that a public library board shall be comprised of at least five members appointed by the municipal council;

AND WHEREAS section 10(1) of the *Public Libraries Act, R.S.O.* 1990, Chapter P.44, as amended, provides that a person is qualified to be appointed as a member of a board who is a member of the appointing council;

AND WHEREAS section 10(2) of the *Public Libraries Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter P.44, as amended, provides that the appointing council shall not appoint more of its own members to a board than the number that is, in the case of a public library board or union board, one less than a majority of the board;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council wishes to amend the composition of The London Public Library Board;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

- 1. The London Public Library Board shall be composed of the following nine (9) members to be appointed by the Municipal Council:
 - (a) two (2) members of the Municipal Council; and
 - (b) seven (7) citizens-at-large.
- 2. By-law No. A.-6656-124, being "A By-law respecting the composition of The London Public Library Board", passed on April 18, 2011, is hereby repealed.
- 3. This by-law comes into force and effect on December 1, 2014.
