- ✓ NWLRC has received \$56,476 from council directed funding since the centre's inception without any increase over the years
- ✓ This has challenged us to be creative with our budgets, seeking other sources of funding and work with the neighbourhood to make it happen
- ✓ But we can only do so much



What are we requesting?

Operating Funds

Staff Wages:

- √ \$25,000 to support a second staff for Community Development initiatives:
 - ✓ Will provide us with the capacity to effectively respond to the needs identified by residents
 - More opportunities that support the London Strengthening Neighbourhoods Strategy can be supported and residents can be better empowered

Rent:

√ \$15,000 to support an increase in rent and the move to a
sustainable model for the growing centre
