RECOMMENDATION

That, on the recommendation of the Director, Land Use Planning and City Planner, in response to the letter of appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board, dated November 1, 2011 and received by the City Clerk on November 3, 2011, and submitted by Robert Malpass, President of the Fairmont Lawn Bowling Club, on behalf of the Fairmont Lawn Bowling Club, relating to Official Plan Application No. O-7668 concerning the London Psychiatric Hospital Secondary Plan described as 840 and 850 Highbury Avenue North and 1414 and 1340 Dundas Street and lands without municipal address east of 850 Highbury Avenue North and bounded by the Canadian Pacific and Canadian National Railways, the Ontario Municipal Board **BE ADVISED** that the Municipal Council has reviewed its decision relating to this matter and sees no reason to alter it.

PREVIOUS REPORTS PERTINENT TO THIS MATTER

December 12, 2005 – Information report to Planning Committee regarding a process for planning the redevelopment of the London Psychiatric Hospital Lands.

April 21, 2009 – Meeting to table the draft London Psychiatric Hospital Lands Area Plan Terms of Reference and circulate it for comment.

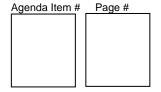
June 22, 2009 – Public Meeting for consideration of the adoption of the London Psychiatric Hospital Lands Area Plan Terms of Reference.

June 13, 2011 – Public Meeting for consideration of endorsement of the Secondary Plan and Stormwater Management Class Environmental Assessment.

September 26, 2011 – Public Meeting for consideration of approval of the Secondary Plan and Stormwater Management Class Environmental Assessment.

BACKGROUND

Following a comprehensive public consultation and planning review process, the Director of Land Use Planning & City Planner brought forward a report to the Built and Natural Environment Committee on September 26, 2011, recommending the introduction for Council adoption, of the proposed Official Plan amendment for the London Psychiatric Hospital Secondary Plan. The purpose and effect of this recommendation was to put Official Plan policies in place providing a



framework for the future development of the subject lands, supporting the conservation of the existing historically significant buildings, cultural features and environmental features on the site, while guiding future development in terms of the location and types of land uses, provision of passive and active recreational spaces, urban design, municipal servicing infrastructure and road networks, and phasing of development.

On November 3, 2011, Robert Malpass, President of the Fairmont Lawn Bowling Club, filed an appeal in response to Council's decision. The appeal pertains specifically to lands owned by the Province of Ontario (Management Board Secretariat), located to the rear of 1414 Dundas Street (see Appendix "A", Location Map), which were redesignated from Regional Facility to Multi-family, Medium Density Residential on Schedule "A" of the Official Plan, and as Transit Oriented Corridor Policy Area 3 in the Secondary Plan. The new policy would permit a lawn bowling facility on the rear portion of the designated area.

The reasons for appeal are stated as follows: Lawn bowling has been carried out on this parcel of land owned by the Province of Ontario, for over 90 years, the City of London is proposing that our lawn bowling club be moved approx. 15 yards to the north in order to develop our property for commercial purposes, the cost to relocate our facilities is estimated over one million dollars, Council has refused to designate our property for its existing use and also refused to designated our property as a heritage site.

A copy of Schedule 3 to the Secondary Plan is attached as Appendix "B". A copy of the appeal letter from Robert Malpass and the reasons for appeal are attached as Appendix "C". A date for the Ontario Municipal Board hearing has not yet been scheduled. Planning staff have reviewed the appeal letter and see no reason for Council to alter its decision relating to this matter.

Infrastructure Ontario, representing the Province of Ontario which owns the land, has been requested to provide its position on the appeal and has indicated that it will be retaining its own legal counsel.

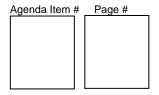

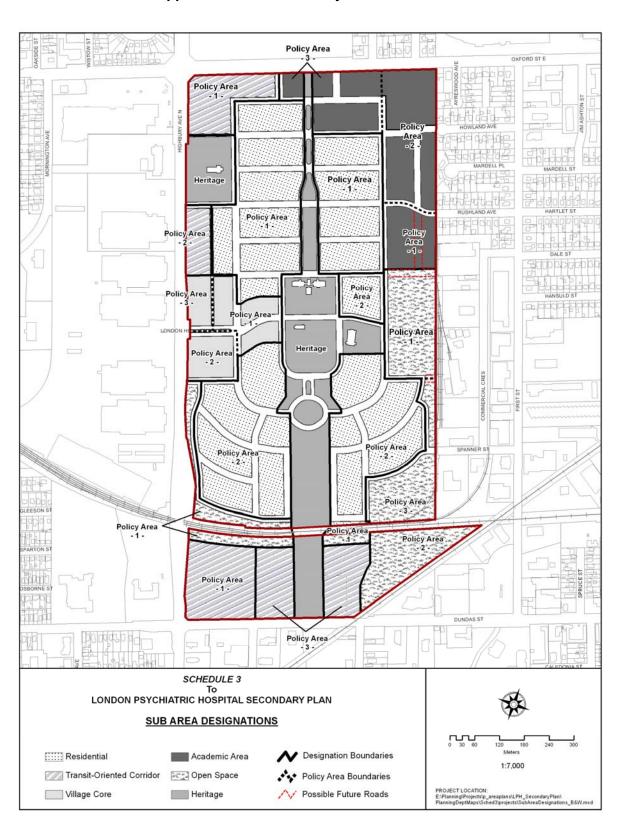


Appendix "A" – Location Map

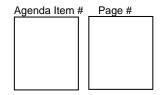

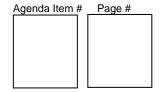
