## Our Move Forward: London's Downtown Plan


- Recommended as Transformational Project #1 – Dundas Place
- Revitalizing the downtown as a preeminent destination





# Dundas Place Scoping Study

- Approved in December 2012
- Summarize existing conditions, capture vision and propose design concepts
- Linked to Downtown Plan, TMP, draft London Plan, Downtown Heritage Conservation District Plan



- a) Queens Avenue Extension
- b) Dundas Street Reconstruction
- c) King Street Extension
- d) Thames River Road Construction


Develop a street system in the study area compatible with the 20-year traffic needs, bearing in mind the overall concepts set forth in the London Traffic Report of April 1966.





### **Project Description**

- From Wellington Street to the Forks of the Thames
- Transform a conventional downtown public right-ofway into a public space
- Flexibility of use












### **Project Components**

- Transit re-routing off Dundas
- On-street parking study
- Coordinated infrastructure improvements including significant London Hydro
- Operating entity envisioned








#### Costs and Schedule

- \$16 M Capital + Operating
- LTC \$1.5 M Capital +
   Operating
- London Hydro ~\$6 to 10 M
- 6 to 7 Year Schedule
- 4-5 Years of capital construction plus utilities
