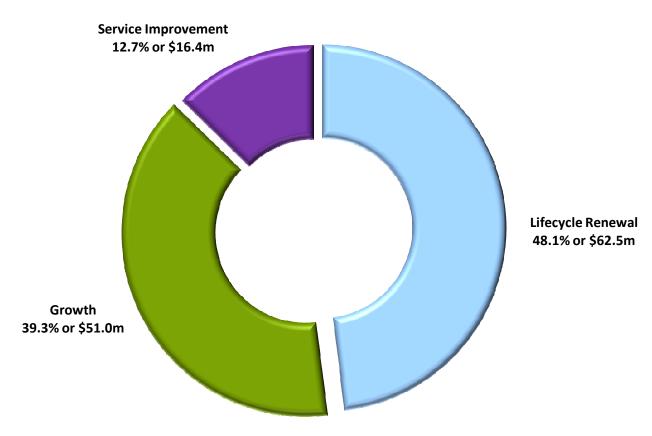

Capital Budget Categories



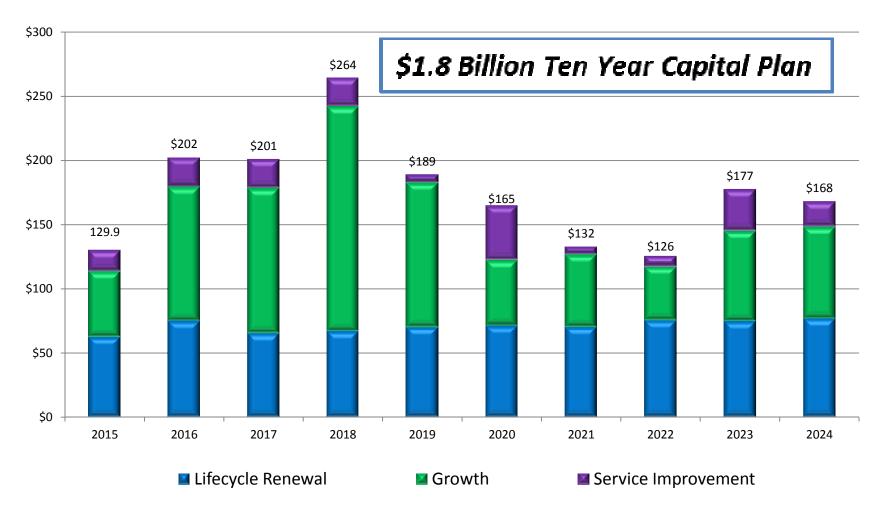

2015 – 2024 (\$ millions)

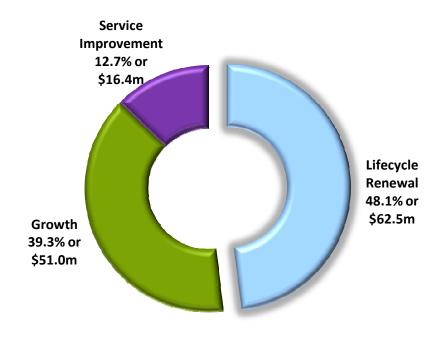

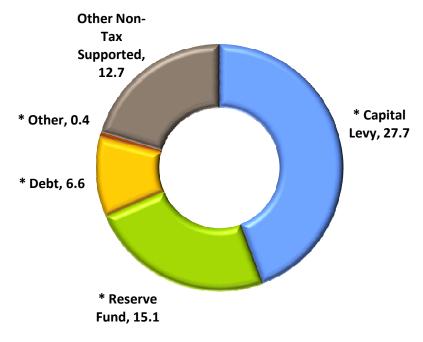

Lifecycle Renewal Funding Sources= \$62.5 million



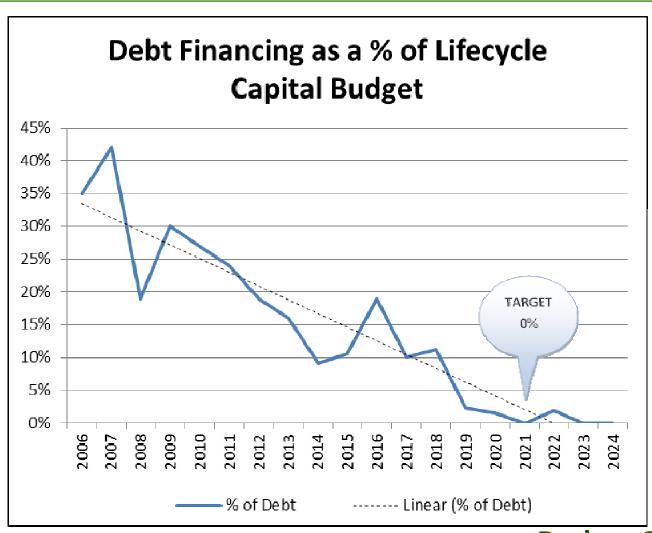

Life Cycle Debt Financing



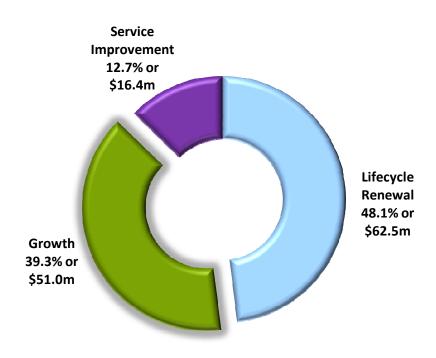

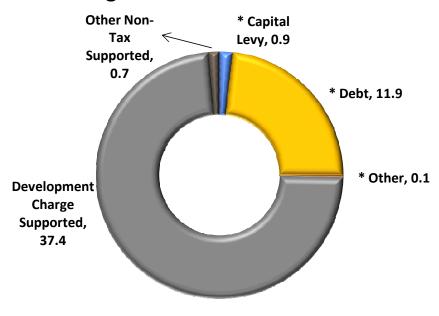

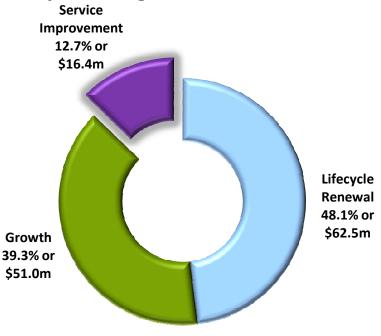

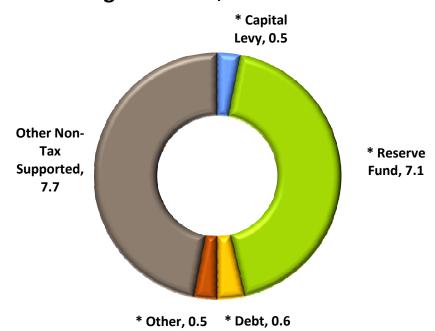
