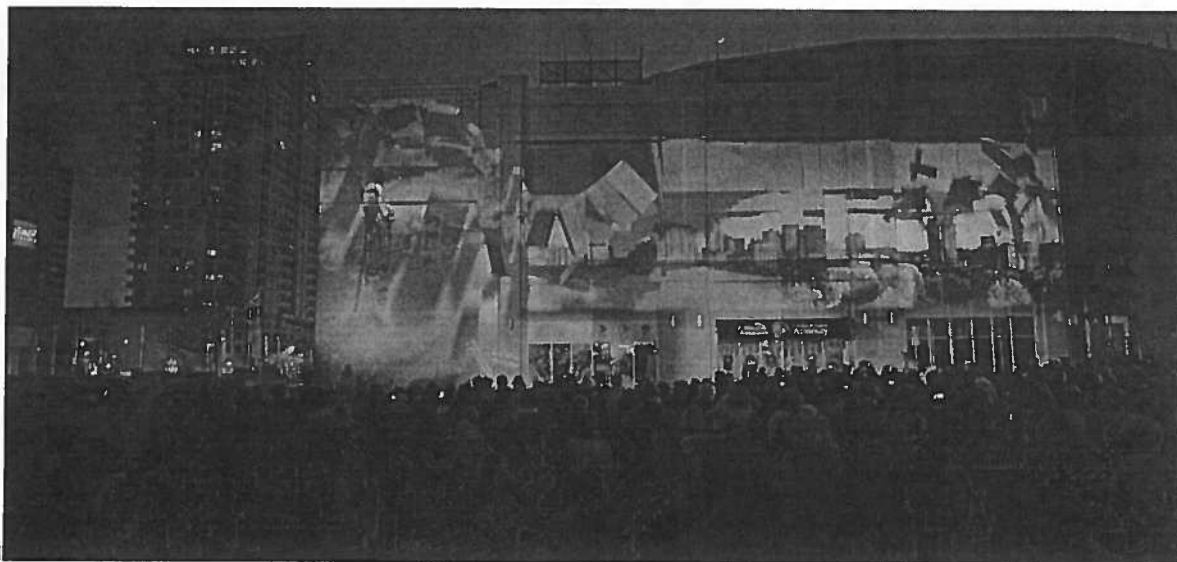

Our Move Forward: London's Downtown Plan

- Recommended as Transformational Project #1 – Dundas Place
- Revitalizing the downtown as a preeminent destination



Project Description

- From Wellington Street to the Forks of the Thames
- transform a conventional downtown public right-of-way into a public space
- Similar to a public square
- Flexibility of use



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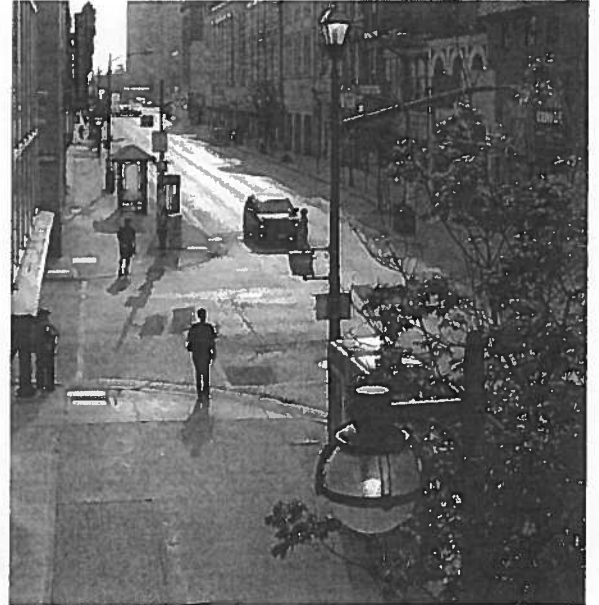
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Project Components

- Transit re-routing off Dundas
- On-street parking study
- Coordinated infrastructure improvements including significant London Hydro
- Operating entity envisioned



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Costs and Schedule

- \$16 M Capital + Operating
- LTC \$1.5 M Capital + Operating
- London Hydro ~\$6 to 10 M
- 6 to 7 Year Schedule
- 4-5 Years of capital construction plus utilities
