

To ensure students' "non-study time" is programmed to keep them safe and socially responsible to the building and the neighbourhood they live in.






- Increased traffic in the residential neighbourhood to the west

Increased Traffic in the Residential Neighbourhood:


(1) Developer agrees topay for the constructionof:






Cross-Section Plan:
