A by-law to amend By-law A.-6151-17, being a by-law to establish policies for the sale and other disposition of land, hiring of employees, procurement of goods and services, public notice, accountability and transparency, and delegation of powers and duties, as required under section 270(1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, in Schedule "C" – Procurement of Goods and Services Policy.

WHEREAS section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS on December 17, 2007 Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacted By-law A.-6151-17, being a by-law to establish policies for the sale and other disposition of land, hiring of employees, procurement of goods and services, public notice, accountability and transparency, and delegation of powers and duties, as required under section 270(1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 (the "Council Policy By-law");

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend the Council Policy By-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

- 1. Schedule "C" to By-law No. A.-6151-17, being the "Procurement of Goods and Services Policy", is hereby amended in part 6.2 c) by adding the words "or an integrity commmisioner" after the words "external auditors".
- 2. Schedule "C" to By-law No. A.-6151-17, being the "Procurement of Goods and Services Policy", is hereby amended by inserting a new part vii in section 8 of Schedule "B" to the Procurement of Goods and Services Policy entitled "Goods and/or Services NOT Subject to this Policy" as follows:
 - "vii Integrity Commissioner Services"
- 3. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the day it is passed.
