


define "Holiday"

- **9.1** Regulations use of water June, July and August For the purpose of limiting the consumption of water as necessary:
 - (a) During the months of June, July and August, the external use of water is permitted:
 - (i) on even calendar dates at only those municipal addresses ending with numbers 0, 2, 4, 6, 8;
 - (ii) on odd calendar dates at only those municipal addresses ending with numbers 1, 3, 5, 7, 9;
 - (iii) on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays at all Municipal Addresses.
 - (b) The engineer is authorized to implement at any time any other regulation which he, in his discretion, considers advisable to limit the external use of water and this authority includes the right to ban completely the external use of water.

(1962 to 2013)





Lawn Watering and Irrigation

The way in which you water your lawn is just as important as how often and how much you water your lawn. It is important to choose the right irrigation system for your landscape.

Did you know?

Most vards and gardens in London are over water by at least 50%!

The City of London has regulations for water use in the months of June, July, and August. The City by-law states that during those months, the external use of water is permitted:

- On even calendar dates at only those municipal addresses ending with numbers 0,2, 4, 6, 8;
- On odd calendar dates at only those municipal addresses ending with numbers 1, 3, 5, 7, 9.
- and there are no restrictions on weekends and statutory holidays. *pending by-law approval

Tips:

- Water your lawn and garden only when necessary and according to municipal by-laws.
- Purchase a rain gauge to determine how much rain or irrigation your yard has already received each
