NOTICE OF PUBLIC PARTICIPATION MEETING - June 15, 2015

A request was submitted by Southside Construction Management Ltd. on May 19, 2015 for the demolition of this heritage designated property in the Downtown Heritage Conservation District. In accordance with section 42 (4) of the Ontario Heritage Act, municipal Council has 90 days thereafter to make a decision on the demolition request. It also must consult with the London Advisory Committee on Heritage [LACH].

It is a policy and practice of Council that the proposed demolition of heritage designated properties shall be considered at a public participation meeting before the Planning and Environment Committee. As an area property owner, this letter is to advise that the Planning and Environment Committee will consider the request to demolish this structure at its meeting on Monday, June 15, 2015, on the second floor, City Hall, 300 Dufferin Avenue (northeast corner of Wellington and Dufferin) not before 7:15 p.m.
