SUBJECT:	LOCAL RENEWABLE ELECTRICITY GENERATION PROJECTS SEEKING ONTARIO FEED-IN TARIFF CONTRACTS
	FEED-IN-TARIFF (FIT) PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS FOR FIT 3.1 CONTRACT HOLDERS

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

That, on the recommendation of the Manager of Development Services and Planning Liaison, the following actions be taken with respect to local renewable electricity generation projects seeking contracts under Version 3.1 of the Ontario Feed-In Tariff (FIT) program:

- a) Council of The Corporation of the City of London SUPPORTS the construction and operation of rooftop solar projects under the Feed-in-Tariff Program (FIT) contract version 3.1 anywhere in the municipality; and
- b) the Mayor and the City Clerk **BE AUTHORIZED** to sign any requested Council Resolution using the Municipal Council Blanket Support Resolution <u>attached</u> hereto as Appendix "A".

### PREVIOUS REPORTS PERTINENT TO THIS MATTER

July 23, 2012 – Report to PEC on municipal support resolutions for local renewable electricity generation projects seeking Ontario Feed-in-Tariff (FIT) Contracts.

September 24, 2012 – Follow-up report to PEC on municipal support resolutions for local renewable electricity generation projects seeking Ontario FIT Contracts.

January 8, 2013 – Report to PEC on Planning Fees By-law CP-18, to implement fees for applications under the FIT Program.

October 29, 2013 – Report to PEC on projects seeking contracts under Version 3.0 of the Ontario FIT Program.


June 1, 2015 – Report to PEC on projects seeking contracts under Version 4.0 of the Ontario FIT Program.

## PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to supplement previous Municipal Council support resolutions, with a resolution required by the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) with a blanket resolution that enables suppliers to proceed with work under contracts that have been issued for FIT Version 3.1 projects in London.

### BACKGROUND

The Provincial Feed-in-Tariff (FIT) Program was launched in 2009 to encourage the development of renewable energy technology, attract investment and create new clean energy jobs in Ontario. Renewable energy projects that are supported through FIT include rooftop and ground mounted solar installations, wind turbines, biomass and biogas. The program allows homeowners,



communities, business owners and private developers to generate renewable energy and sell it to the province at a guaranteed price for a fixed contract term.

The FIT program was previously administered by the Ontario Power Authority (OPA) and is now administered by the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO). The program is updated annually and projects are awarded on the basis of points that are assigned for a variety of attributes, including support from local municipal councils which must be in the prescribed format. The program criteria requires updated municipal council support resolutions that are specific to each version of FIT, with standardized wording for the resolutions prescribed by the IESO.

A blanket Council resolution for new projects under FIT Version 4.0 was recommended in a report to the June 1<sup>st</sup> PEC meeting and endorsed by Council on June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2015. The City has recently been advised that in addition to the blanket resolution for projects under Version 4.0, the IESO also requires a blanket resolution for projects that were previously issued contracts under FIT Version 3.1, so that they can proceed through to the development stages of their contract with IESO. Several contracts have been awarded in London and contract holders are required to obtain a new blanket resolution for these sites.

The sole purpose of the recommended resolution is to allow suppliers to proceed under their FIT Version 3.1 contracts for rooftop solar installations, and does not apply to any other form of municipal approval. No changes are proposed to the category types or fee structure for processing applications, which were established through an amendment to By-law CP-18 - adopted by Council on January 15, 2013, and illustrated in Table 1 below:

The action being recommended at this time is the endorsement of the Municipal Council resolution form prepared by the Province for contracts issued under the FIT 3.1 program. The Municipal Council Blanket Support Resolution for FIT 3.1 contracts is attached as Appendix "A". The actual Municipal Council Support Resolution form to be signed and provided to applicants for blanket resolutions for FIT 3.1 contracts is attached as Appendix "B".



Municipal Council is being requested to endorse a blanket resolution form for rooftop solar panel applications that were issued contracts under the Provincial FIT 3.1 program. The purpose of the resolution is to enable suppliers to proceed with the implementation of their contracts with the Independent Electricity System Operator.
