The Register and the Ontario Heritage Act

Section 27 of the OHA states that the Register will include:

"all property situated in the municipality that has been designated by the municipality or by the Minister under this Part."

Section 27 also states that the Register may include property that is not designated, but that the council "believes to be of cultural heritage value or interest."



- Lacks heritage properties that have recently been listed and designated, including HCD properties.
- Does not reflect demolitions that have occurred since 2005.



Project Goal

1) To update the existing Inventory of Heritage Resources, to include new designations, listings, and recent demolitions.



Project Chronology to Date

- Completed background research on the Heritage Registers of other Ontario municipalities
- 2) Cross-referenced the current inventory with the working register
- 3) Transferred the rankings of Part V properties to the working register
- 4) Identified Part IV designated properties with interior attributes
- 5) Identified demolished properties
- 6) Identified properties outside of HCDs that have been designated and listed since 2005




Priority Levels

- London's inventory uses priority levels: Priority 1, Priority
 2, Priority 3, & Priority 9
- Identified two municipalities in Ontario that use priority levels: Oshawa and St. Catharines
- All properties that are individually designated or listed have heritage value or interest.
- Priority levels are often used to justify demolitions for properties with lower priority levels.



Properties Included in the Register


Designated and Listed Properties






Part IV Designated Properties






Designated Heritage Properties
