



NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE #1 "London ON Bikes" CITY OF LONDON CYCLING MASTER PLAN

In March 2015, the City of London began developing a new Cycling Master Plan – "London **ON** Bikes". The Plan is building on the previous *2005 Bicycle Master Plan* and the *2007 Bicycle Master Plan Implementation Study*. The master plan process will be consistent with Phases 1 and 2 of the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (2007& 2011)*.

Purpose of the Study:

Since the start of the study, the team has:

- 1. Prepared maps of existing and previously proposed conditions and identified routes that will be reviewed and assessed by the study team;
- 2. Identified a vision for the master plan as well as a problem / opportunity statement;
- 3. Reviewed best practices from other municipalities and;
- 4. Reviewed existing City policies and plans and determined how they influence the City's new Cycling Master Plan.
