Bill No. 319 2015

By-law No. PS-111-15\_\_\_

A by-law to amend By-law PS-111 entitled, "A by-law to regulate traffic and the parking of motor vehicles in the City of London."

WHEREAS subsection 10(2) paragraph 7. of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws to provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable to the public;

AND WHEREAS subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. No Parking in Unposted Locations

Section 9 No Parking In Unposted Locations of the By-law PS-111 is hereby amended by **deleting** the following:

- a) in such a manner so that any part of the vehicle is situated upon or over a sidewalk at any time of the day or night;
- b) between a sidewalk and the adjacent roadway at any time;

Section 9 No Parking In Unposted Locations of the By-law PS-111 is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

- a) at any time in such a manner so that any part of the vehicle is situated upon or over a sidewalk;
- b) at any time between a sidewalk and the adjacent roadway where the shortest distance between the sidewalk and the roadway is less than 5.5 meters;
- 2. This by-law comes into force and effect on January 4, 2016.
