CITY OF LONDON CYCLING MASTER PLAN**

London ON Bikes is the process to create a new Cycling Master Plan. The project is being completed in four (4) phases. Phases 1 and 2 are complete. The project team is looking for your input on the proposed cycling routes and draft facility types and to help identify potential policy and programming priorities.



Purpose of the Study:

Since the last public information centre held in June 2015, the project team has investigated candidate routes and identified a draft network of proposed facilities considering input received. The project team has also considered key cycling topics that need to be addressed in the cycling master plan including bicycle parking, route maintenance, cycling on sidewalks, signage and wayfinding.
