

ON INITIATION

By-law No. S.A.S.-_____

A by-law to authorize the construction of a sanitary sewer, storm sewer and water main on Perkins Road as a local improvement pursuant to section 5 of Ontario Regulation 586/06 under the *Municipal Act, 2001*.

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of London “the Corporation” has initiated the construction of a sanitary sewer, storm sewer and water main on Perkins Road “the Work”;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation has initiated the Work in accordance with section 2(1) of Ontario Regulation 586/06, Local Improvement Charges – Priority Lien Status, filed under the *Municipal Act, 2001*, “the Regulation”;

WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass a by-law to undertake the Work as a local improvement has been given to the public and to the owners of the lots liable to be specially charged in accordance with section 5 of the Regulation;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation has not received a sufficient petition in accordance with section 10 of the Regulation not to proceed with the Work;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of London enacts as follows:

1. The Corporation shall undertake the Work as a local improvement for the purpose of raising part of the cost of the Work by imposing special charges in accordance with the provisions set out in the Regulation on lots that abut on the Work as attached in Schedule “A”.
2. The estimated cost of the Work is \$510,000.
3. The owners’ share of the cost of the Work is 66.67% estimated at \$254,999.25 comprised of the estimated special charge per metre of frontage of \$604.29.
4. The Corporation’s share of the cost of the Work is 33.33% estimated at \$127,500.00
5. The General Manager of Environmental and Engineering Services & City Engineer is authorized to prepare all necessary plans, specifications and reports required for and to supervise the construction of the Work.
6. This by-law comes into force and effect on the day it is passed.
