The City of London is currently undertaking the design for the next phase of the Sarnia Road Improvements project. This letter provides you with information about the project and a public meeting.

## **Project Details**

Location:

Sarnia Road - Wonderland Road to Sleightholme Avenue

Schedule: Tentatively scheduled for Spring 2016 to Fall 2016

Scope:

- Widening of Sarnia Road to four lanes plus auxiliary lanes
- Full reconstruction including curb and gutter, sidewalks, and on-road bicycle lanes
- Installation of noise barrier walls
- Streetscape features including a parkette at northeast corner of intersection of Sarnia and Wonderland Road
- Roadway illumination
- Watermain and water services
- Sanitary/storm sewers and private drain connections where requested
