RE: Monthly Report for August 2015

Attached are the Building Division's monthly report for August 2015 and copies of the Summary of the Inspectors' Workload reports.

#### Permit Issuance

By the end of August, 2,506 permits had been issued with a construction value of approximately \$483 million dollars, representing 956 new dwelling units. Compared to last year, this represents a 10% decrease in the number of permits, a 5.4% decrease in the construction value and an 18% decrease in the number of dwelling units.

To the end of August, the number of single and semi-detached dwellings issued were 403, which was a 20% decrease over last year.

At the end of August, there were 424 applications in process, representing approximately \$354 million dollars in construction value and an additional 783 dwelling units, compared with 635 applications having a construction value of \$316 million dollars and an additional 1,063 dwelling units for the same period last year.

The rate of incoming applications for the month of August averaged out to 19.5 applications a day for a total of 390 in 20 working days. There were 63 permit applications to build 63 new single detached dwellings, 6 townhouse applications to build 14 units, of which 3 were cluster single dwelling units.

There were 407 permits issued in August totalling \$46.9 million including 55 new dwelling units.

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#### **Inspections**

Although multiple inspections may be booked and completed for a project on the same day (ie. structural framing and HVAC rough-in), only one inspection is counted in this report. This provides a more accurate depiction of the inspectors' workload.

Building Inspectors received 1,621 inspection calls and conducted 2,578 building permit related inspections with an additional inspection completed relating to complaints, licenses, orders and miscellaneous inspections. This is a total of 2,576 inspections or an average of 258 inspections made per inspector this month based on 10 inspectors, which averages out to 19.8 inspections per day per inspector. (Note: 200 person working days – 73 vac/sick day/training = 130) There are a total of 8,931 active building permits or an average of 893 permits per inspector. The provincially mandated requirement to inspect within 48 hours of receipt of an inspection request was achieved 98% of the time.

Plumbing Inspectors received 713 inspection calls and conducted a total of 1,133 permit related inspections. There was 1 inspection performed that related to the Backflow Prevention Program. Inspections relating to complaints, orders and miscellaneous calls totalled a further 1 inspection. During the month, a total of 1,135 inspections were conducted with an average of 227 per inspector, which averages out to 12.34 inspections per day per inspector. (Note: 100 person working days – 18 vac/sick day/training = 92). Active building permits involving plumbing totalled 2,546 or 509 on average per inspector. The provincially mandated requirement to inspect within 48 hours of receipt of an inspection request was achieved 98.4% of the time.




