Encourage attendance by ACE members to other city meetings including the Civic Works Committee, and Council meetings.	As discussed at the November ACE meeting, an informal calendar document will be tried in dropbox so that individuals can indicate which meetings they plan on attending or reviewing online.
Coordinate and encourage participation of ACE members in London Clean & Green in the Spring.	Will encourage via general communication support.
Initiate an Online Member Drive to be spearheaded by ACE members for specific purposes such as increasing subscriptions to the city's enewsletter, Twitter followers, Facebook likes, engagement etc.	Added to work plan. Further planning to be conducted.
Encourage and facilitate internal committee communication including setting up Dropbox for sub-committees, establishing a standard reporting format for sub-committee & individual reports, establishing a discussion or document on Meeting Best Practices etc.	Added to work plan.
Support the roll out / focus of Active & Green Communities and Project Neutral Software in 2016 or other key programs such as cycling/climate change programs.	The timing and activities of the Online Engagement Drives will support this.
As Time Allows	
Coordinate/encourage education of ACE members regarding existing environmental programs in the City of London. Might include coordinating speakers - city staff, from local environmental groups etc.	Recommending that ACE set a guideline of having at least one field trip every year and a minimum of one outside speaker per year. Coordinating tours, speakers to be done within ACE members. Reevaluate the Education & Outreach subcommittees role in this if it has more members in the future.

Hold a meeting with Greg Barret - Planning For Future Consideration	As time allows, Mary Ann and I will request a meeting with Greg similar to the one we had with Jay. Will aim to touch base with Jay and Greg each January starting in 2017.
Look at how other cities are communicating about their environmental programs and provide ideas/specific examples to Jay's department.	Not at this time.
Assess the current communications initiatives overall or for a specific project of the City of London related to the environment. (Possibly including qualitative feedback/observations, as well as analyzing Google Analytics data, Facebook insights data, etc.)	Not at this time.
Investigate whether it would be appropriate for ACE to support LEN.	Not at this time.
Host an event and/or participate within another event.	The resources needed for such an initiative are quite significant and would include handouts, display materials, planning meetings and event coverage by ACE members. The purpose of such outreach is also unclear. Topic specific initiatives are already covered by the City. Event involvement could be reviewed if a specific topic needs awareness and/or the Education & Outreach sub-committee grows.
