Hi Betty,

Would it be too late to add an item to the LACH agenda? It's regarding our extra funds, I'd like to propose we give a portion to the London Public Library's Historic Sites Committee to be used for plaques.

If the Historic Sites Committee were to receive any general funds, they would be used in this priority:

1. Plaque for Nature London (Springbank Park)(no funding)
2. Plaque commemorating the London oil industry (All Saints Church)(no funding)
3. Plaque for Dr Edwin Seaborn & Western's Military Hospital (Western)(partial funding from UWO)

In development are also plaques for the first London Public Library branch (fully funded by LPL), the Roundhouse (early stages of development), and potentially the Glass Bros Pottery Factory/Pottersburg (extremely early stages of development).

For those interested, the last funds that the HSC received from LACH were used for the plaques and unveiling receptions for St Peter's Seminary (half), the Hydro Shop (half), Southwest Traction Line, and Farmer's Advocate.
