

## Top Picks – The List of Buildings that should be Designated

Updated November 2008

1. 609 Dundas Street at Adelaide - Lilley's Corners
2. 925 Dundas Street – Western Fairgrounds Art Gallery
3. 7 – 11 York Street – London’s first hospital
4. 275 Thames Street - the original African Methodist Episcopal Church
5. 1152 Dundas Street - the old truck factory.
6. 754 Dundas Street ( Hick’s block)
7. St. Peter's Basilica, Dufferin & Richmond
8. St. Mary's Church, Lyle & York
9. All Saints Anglican Church on Hamilton Road
10. Great West Beef Co. - the front part, the old railroad roundhouse.
11. Pilgrim Reformed Church - 465 Horton at Maitland - connections to the Underground Railroad.
12. 22 Maitland St - this is one of our last remaining old factories (now L.H.Smith Fruit Company)
13. The Old Victoria Hospital site - various buildings, particularly the Colborne Building
14. 213 – 215 Dundas Street at Clarence – Spettigue/Duffield Block
15. 332 – 336 Richmond Street at York – Grigg House hotel
16. 366 – 368 Richmond Street at King – Imperial Bank building
17. 388 – 390 Richmond Street – Victoria Building
18. Buildings on the site of the old Sanatorium, Sanatorium Road.
19. Buildings on the site of the old London Asylum, Highbury ave.
20. Industrial buildings on Cabell Street, near Rectory just south of the railroad tracks. 820 and 825 Cabell are two examples of long lost history of London's industrial past.
21. Huron and Erie (Canada Trust) - NE Corner of Dundas and Clarence
22. 247 & 249 Halls Mill Road including the barn
23. 1184 Hamilton Road – Siddall House – at Pottersburg Creek
24. 2056 Huron Street – the house in the grove

25. 15 to 21 Stanley Street – Lancaster Terrace
26. 1148 Richmond Street – 1864 Ontario farmhouse
27. 640 Richmond Street – the Toddle Inn
28. 175 Dundas Street – east of Richmond, south side
29. 156 Wortley Road – third door north of Bruce St., east side
30. 216 York Street – the York Hotel, now “Call the Office”
31. 671 Richmond Street – the C.P.R. Hotel (the CEEPS)

Also of concern to LACH, as recommended elsewhere – the Talbot Street properties between Fullarton and Mill Street. These include the following properties:

- 479 to 489 Talbot – Camden Terrace
- 505, 507, 511, 529, 531, 535, 537 Talbot
- 106 Kent Street
- 545, 555, 557, 568/570/572, 580, 585, 593/595 Talbot
- 601, 607, 611, 618, 619, 628, 629, 638, 640, 644, 646, 678 Talbot
- 651 and 653 Talbot are of special interest
- 116 Mill Street
- 513, 652, 672/674, 680 Talbot Street are already Designated

Similar concern for the houses on Central Avenue facing Victoria Park – at Council’s request, Reasons for Designation were written for these houses and they were recommended for Designation in November 2005 but the recommendation has been ignored to date. These include the following properties:

- 268 Central/605 Wellington Street
- this list would have included #252 Central but it was demolished as we worked on it
