Dear London Civic Works Committee,

The London Middlesex Road Safety Committee supports the recommendation of the Managing Director, Environmental & Engineering Services and City Engineer with respect to the Red Light Camera Program for London.

The London Middlesex Road Safety Committee's mission is to save lives and reduce serious injuries to all road users using the 7 E's of injury prevention through leadership, innovation, coordination, and program support in partnership with public and private organizations. Our goal is to support and achieve the benchmarks outlined in the London Road Safety Strategy, to reach a 10% reduction in injury causing and fatal collision over 5 years.

To date, the committee has implemented two road safety educational campaigns addressing key areas of focus; cycling and distracted driving. These educational campaigns are most successful when they are supported by enforcement and engineering efforts. The Red Light Camera Program is listed as Action Item #35 in the London Road Safety Strategy and is a significant component to reducing the number of collisions that occur due to red light running.

The London Middlesex Road Safety Committee supports the implementation of the Red Light Camera Program and will work with its partners to promote the City of London's proposed education and awareness campaigns projected for 2017.
